

This Indenture

made the twenty fifth day
of June One thousand

nine hundred and twenty four Between Alan Crockford of
Aylesford in the County of Kent Builder and Contractor (hereinafter
called the Vendor) of the one part and Walter Frank Smith of
Aylesford Kent Builder and Contractor (hereinafter called the Purchaser)
of the other part Whereas the Vendor is now seized in fee simple
in possession free from incumbrances of the hereditaments hereinafter
described and has agreed to sell the same to the Purchaser for the like
estate in possession free from incumbrances at the price of Five hundred
pounds Now this Indenture witnesseth that in
pursuance of the said agreement and in consideration of the sum of
Five hundred pounds (on or before the execution of these presents)
paid by the Purchaser to the Vendor (the receipt of which sum the
Vendor hereby acknowledges) the Vendor as Beneficial Owner hereby
conveys unto the Purchaser Firstly A R that piece or parcel of land
situate at New Aylesford in the County of Kent lying on the north



side of a road leading from Jacklyns Lane to the Aylesford Railway Station and which said piece of land is more particularly delineated on the plan drawn hereon and thereon coloured pink. Together with the messuages or dwellinghouses erected thereon and known as No^t 488 Station Approach and Secondly full right and liberty for the Purchaser his heirs and assigns and all persons authorised by him in common with the other persons entitled thereto at all times hereafter to pass and repass over and along the roadways coloured green on the said plan either with or without horses carts carriages motor cars and other vehicles at all times and for all purposes but subject to the liability of the Purchaser and the persons deriving title under him to pay a rateable proportion with the other persons entitled as aforesaid of the expense of keeping the said roadways in repair such proportion to be fixed by the Vendor's surveyor whose decision shall be final ~~to hold~~ unto and to the use of the Purchaser in fee simple It is hereby certified that the transaction hereby effected does not form part of a larger transaction or of a series of transactions in respect of which the amount or value or the aggregate amount or value of the consideration exceeds Five hundred pounds And the Vendor hereby acknowledges the right of the Purchaser to production of the documents mentioned in the schedule hereto and to delivery of copies thereof.
